You will contribute to the research and teaching portfolio of the Comparative Public Policy research unit (<https://www.uni-bamberg.de/policy/>). Research at the chair focuses on the political economy of the welfare state in historical and international comparative perspective. Methods applied include quantitative instruments such as panel data analyses and spatial econometrics as well as qualitative techniques such as process tracing. Contribution to third-party funding applications, active cooperation with other projects and participation in joint activities are expected. Furthermore, the successful candidate has the opportunity for further scientific qualification.

- Finished (or almost finished) doctoral degree in Political Science or a related discipline
- In-depth knowledge in comparative public policy
- Experience in quantitative empirical research preferably in the analyses of geocoded data
- Programming skills in STATA, Python or R
- Excellent writing and communication skills in English
- Interest in interdisciplinary work and in historically oriented political science
- Good organizational skills as well as the willingness and capacity for teamwork
