Full Professor in Political Science, Evidence-based Political Research (W3, Chair)

beginning at 1 August 2023.

The University of Mannheim is looking for a scholar with outstanding commitment to strengthen the department's expertise in the field of evidence-based political science. Applicants should have published in leading international journals and should have a causal-analytical research agenda that addresses questions in the fields of International Relations, Comparative Government or Political Behavior. Ideally, the candidate is able to conduct innovative research and teaching in several subdisciplines.

The successful candidate must have a university and doctoral degree, commitment to excellence in teaching, and documented excellence in research. The candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses.

The University of Mannheim offers an international environment with institutionalized commitment to promote outstanding academic careers in the Graduate School of Economic and Social Sciences (GESS) and the EITM Europe Summer Institute, and to recruit competitive third-party funds in the Mannheim Centre for European Social Research (MZES).

The appointment requirements are determined by § 47 LHG of the State of Baden-Württemberg. The University of Mannheim places great emphasis on the training and mentoring of students and therefore expects full-time presence of its teaching staff and the ability to teach in English. In order to foster the integration of the University into the region, it is expected that professors move to Mannheim or the larger metropolitan area.

The University of Mannheim is an equal opportunity employer. Applicants with disabilities are treated with preference given comparable qualification. The University seeks to increase the number of women in research and teaching and thus strongly and explicitly encourages qualified female scholars to apply.
