Your responsibilities include:

- A doctoral research project that concerns itself with intrastate dynamics of societal mobilization and repression, such as in the context of shrinking civic spaces and violence against social activists;
- Participation in scientific publications, acquisition of external funds, and scientific transfer endeavors of the Research Department in addition to participation in the research network "External Democracy Promotion" (EDP https://www.external-democracy-promotion.eu/).

As applicant, you should fulfill the following requirements:

- Above-average degree (at least "gut" according to the German Grading System) in political science, sociology, or another relevant discipline that grants eligibility for the pursuit of a doctoral degree;
- Scientific interest in the field of peace and conflict studies with a focus on processes of political transformation, contentious politics, and/or dynamics of intrastate conflict and violence;
- Well-founded knowledge of quantitative and/or qualitative social-science methods;
- Ability to work well in an international team;
- Willingness and ability to present research to the scientific community and general public;
- Good spoken and written command of English and eagerness to learn German during the time of employment.

You can expect:

- Flexible hours that allow for the balance of work time and family life;
- Possibility to work remotely;
- Scientific work in a highly relevant and diverse field with a motivated and well-connected international team of colleagues;
- A company pension scheme provided by the Versorgungsanstalt des Bundes und der Länder (VBL).
